

WEALTH GAP SERIES

As of 2015, research by the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston defined the median net worth of a white family was \$247,500, while the median net worth of a Black family was \$8. To help address this inequity, the Chamber has launched a series to advance the business community's awareness of and commitment to closing the racial wealth gap. The series will highlight cutting-edge solutions to the persistent inequities seen in Boston and create a space for collaboration among the city's business and community leaders.

Speakers will include business, government, and non-profit leaders. Attendees can expect to leave with research and data as well as necessary next steps to close the racial wealth gap.
