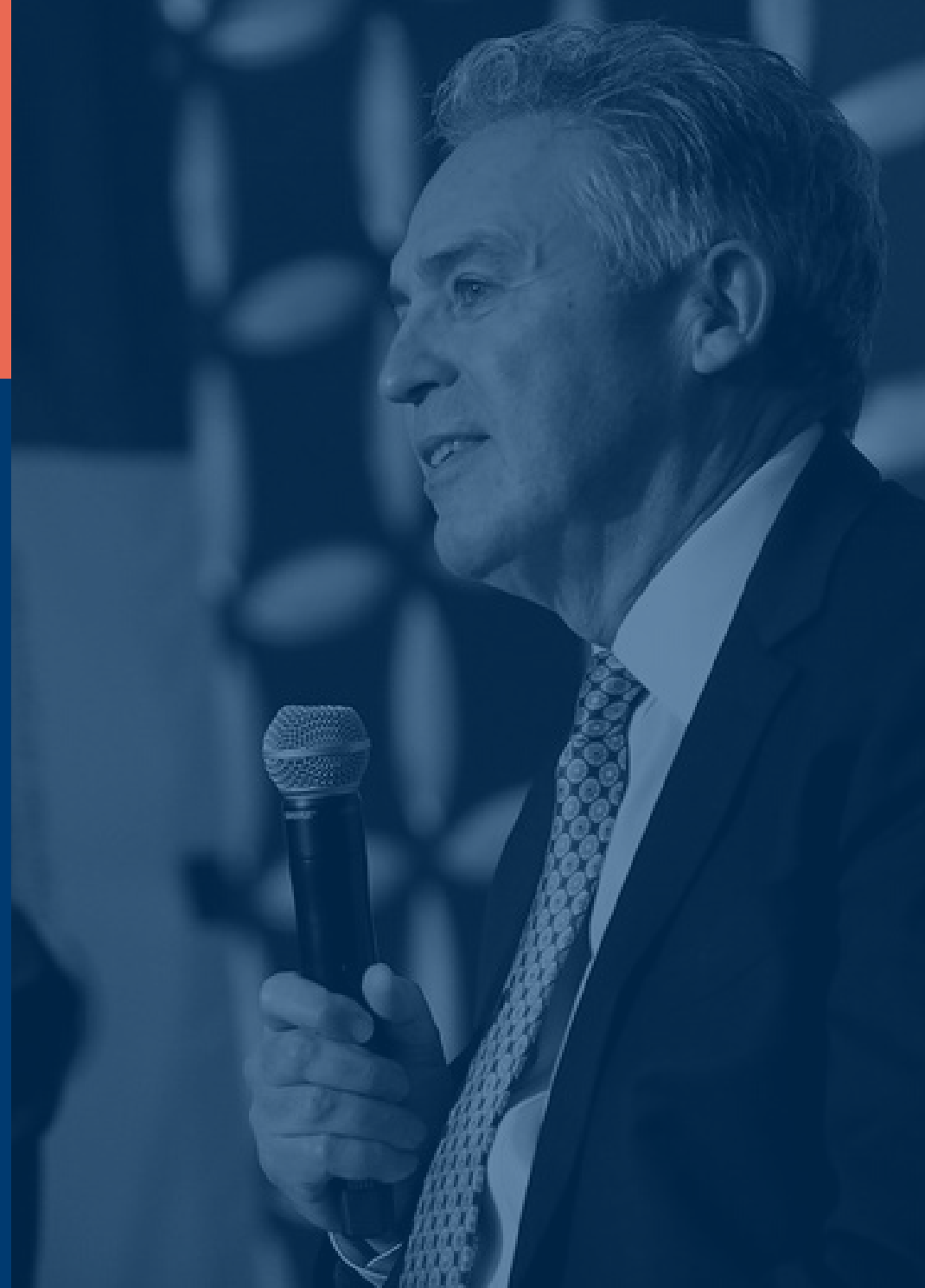

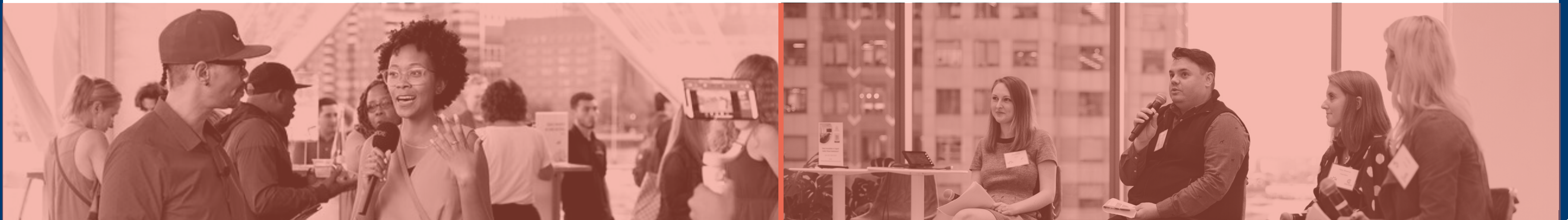

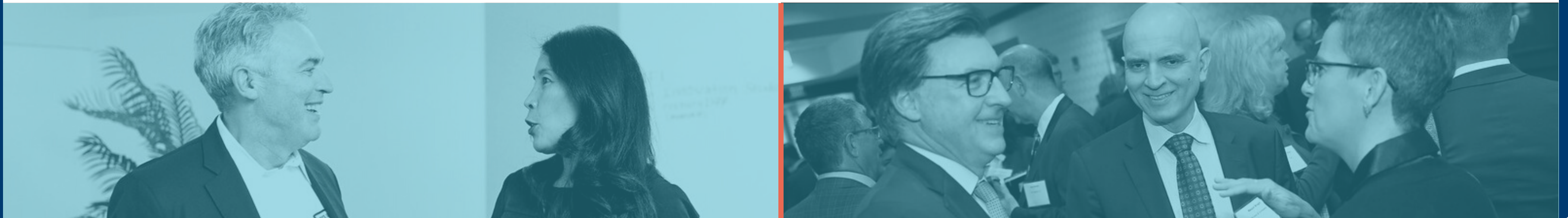
### CEO Forums
