Each Certificate series consists of six sessions for up to 75 participants.

Notable results from past participant survey:

As a result of taking the DEI certificate program, participants significantly improved their DEI competencies. As a cohort, the group showed measurable growth in mastery levels.

Respondents say they are highly skilled or expert level (4 or 5 out of 5):

64% in understanding DEI concepts

64% in recognizing unconscious bias

59% in gathering input from diverse constituents

45% in conducting difficult conversations

50% in facilitating inclusive meetings

44% in interrupting microaggressions
